SCHOOL WEAR POLICY

Appropriate school wear for boys

- A business-type suit (ie, grey, dark blue, black, pin-stripe, brown – but not bright colours)
- Plain shirt (can be coloured – but not patterned)
- Dark shoes, lace-up or slip on, leather or suede
- We provide the tie
- Sports shorts, socks and shirts (plus swimwear) of your choice for sports sessions
- Casual wear for free time
- No ear-rings to be worn during the school day or at school events and functions
- A single stud may be worn in one ear in free time and casual clothes

Appropriate school wear for girls

- A business-type suit (trousers and matching jacket OR skirt and matching jacket)
- A plain blouse (any colour, non-transparent)
- Smart, plain shoes for a working day - NOT high heels, sports shoes or sandals
- We provide an Earlscliffe pin to be worn on your lapel
- Sports shorts, socks and shirts (plus swimwear) of your choice for sports sessions
- Casual wear for free time
- Ear-rings must be single rings, ie one in each ear, not multiples, and should be studs, except in free time and casual clothes, when longer ear-rings may be worn

Students should bring a bath towel.

Laundry is done once per week.

It is recommended that students have their names labelled into their clothes.

The House Manager may reasonably request students not to wear certain items of clothing if she/he deems them inappropriate, ie skirts which are too short, T-shirts with offensive wording or slogans etc. Students should follow such guidance without argument.
